Norfolk under Regulation 27 – request for statement of conformity with
regional strategy under Regulation 29**

Broadland District Council, Norwich City Council and South Norfolk Council, working with Norfolk County Council as the Greater Norwich Development Partnership, are publishing the proposed submission version of the Joint Core Strategy for the area (except for that for which the Broads Authority is the local planning authority).
