GNDP Response to Inspector's Agenda for 9 December Item 5

5. Taking stock concerning GNDP's proposed new diagrams RF25A (Biodiversity Enhancement Areas) and RF25B (Proposed Green infrastructure Network). Where are these from and, since they have not been seen before, do they require advertisement?

The plans, with minor presentational adaptations for clarity agreed with Natural England, such as showing the GNDP boundary, have been in the public realm for 3 years. They have been consulted on as part of the JCS evidence base and therefore do not require advertisement. The sources of the plans are:
